WORKING THE AIRBRUSH

With the use of a small compressor or stored canned air, the airbrush propels the paint or medium through the airbrush into a fine spray.

The artist can control this, by gauging the amount of pressure placed on the trigger or main lever.

Whatever you want customised, the airbrush artist or hobbyist can do it with a WOLD.

MEDIUMS

WOLD AIRBRUSHES have fine tips from 0.2mm to 0.5mm and we recommend the fine mediums to prolong the life of your airbrush.

Acrylics, solvents, water based colours, inks, dyes and automotive paints can all be used in your WOLD airbrush.
